- Lock up- Lock away all valuables, for example laptops, printers- items which are easily portable should there be a break in
- Data backup-Ensure that all data is backed up in case of data loss due to theft or damage of computer equipment during storms
- Cash-If your business handles cash, make arrangements for Armsec, the Guard-Alert armed guards division, to collect your cash at set times and store it in their vaults, so as to avoid storage of huge amounts of cash on your premises
- Keyholders- Ensure that there are designated



keyholders/ staff that are responsible in case of emergency. These should also be decision makers so that they are decisive when the occasion calls for it

• Power- turn off all unnecessary power points- this will reduce fire hazard in case of any electrical faults, and will also save you on the power bill as there will be no unnecessary power usage

• Emergency contactensure that emergency contact numbers are up-to-date and readily available in case of emergency

• Risk analysis- if unsure of your holiday security needs, contact Guard-Alert Security for a risk analysis so that you can prepare adequately for your security needs.
