A time to rest-but do stay Alert

It is that time again when we take a well deserved break. The Heroes holiday always coincides with the school holidays, therefore it is also a time when most of you travel away from home and also shut down your offices. Here are a few security tips that you should take into account to secure your home and offices, so that you can have peace of mind when you travel.

- Contract a sundry guardwho will look after your premises while you are away. That way you will know that a professional security company is looking after your propert
- Lock up- Lock away all valuables, for example laptops, printers- items which are easily portable should there be a break in
- Cash-If your business handles cash, make arrangements for Armsec, the Guard-Alert armoured guards division, to collect your cash at set times and store it in their vaults, so as to avoid storage of huge amounts of cash on your premises
- Keyholders- Ensure that there are designated keyholders/ staff that are responsible in case of emergency. These should also be decision makers so that they are decisive when the occasion calls for it
- Emergency contact- ensure that emergency contact numbers are readily available in case of emergency
- Lock everything before you leave, including the garage, the gates, shed and power box

- If you have an alarm system, activate it. Give a neighbour or a trusted friend or relative a spare key and the alarm PIN so they can get into the house if needed
- Set timers on lights and appliances, so they come on for a few hours in the evening at times when you would normally be at home
- Put valuables in a safe deposit box
- Don't leave a spare key in a secret spot in the garden. Burglars know where to look.
 Give a key to a trusted neighbour instead
- If you are a vehicle fleet owner, fit your vehicles with **vehicle tracking equipment**-so that you can generate reports on your return and trace if anything untoward
